SIA TO HELP DEVELOP AUSTRALIAN RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PHYSICAL ACTIVITY

Following on from the SIA Industry Leaders Summit on Childhood Obesity held in October last year, SIA has been invited by the Federal Department of Health and Ageing to participate in the establishment of **Australian Recommendations for Health-Promoting Physical Activity for Children and Young People.**

This project is part of the Government's Focus on Prevention Agenda, and will serve as a basis for consistent policy and program development across various sectors in the area of physical activity for children and adolescents. The Recommendations will serve as a community education tool in the promotion of physical activity in young people, and set standards for monitoring physical activity participation rates.

SIA's participation in this process is an important step in the recognition of the role SIA and the sport industry can play in addressing the childhood obesity issue.
