AUSTRALIAN SPORTS FEDERATIONS ALLIANCE

The Australian Sports Federations Alliance (CAS and all State and Territory Sports Federations) met again in Adelaide recently to discuss issues of concern to Australian sport.

After lobbying for the last eighteen months for the introduction of mandatory physical education in schools, the Alliance celebrated the recent announcements by the Federal Government on the introduction of physical education in primary schools.

CAS has also been lobbying for funding for the After School Sport Program, and the Alliance met with Mark Peters to discuss the management and implementation of the Program. The responses from the ASC were very positive, and the Alliance were particularly pleased to see that the program will offer a wide range of sports and activities catering for a range of skill levels.
